The surplus for the year prior to away match grants, including donations from supporters and net of costs of fundraising events and merchandise, was £26k. After the grant of the donations detailed above, carried forward fund reserves were £31k at 31st December 2022 (of which £3k is restricted to be remitted to the Ukraine charity in early 2023).
